WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

- 17 years of age (16 to solo)
- Read, speak and understand English
- Acquire a 3rd class FAA medical
- 40 hours of flight time
- Pass the FAA written test
- Pass the FAA oral and practical flight tests

HOW LONG DOES THE TRAINING TAKE?

Training time will vary from person to person. It comes down to individual aptitude and diligence.

Weather, financials and individual schedule constraints are all factors in the training process.

Approximately six months to one year can be described as the typical time frame for a full-time working individual training on the weekends and occasional weekday.

IS IT SAFE?

General aviation flight is as safe as the quality of maintenance technicians and the pilots at the controls. A competent pilot flying a well maintained aircraft will provide for an extremely safe mode of transportation.

HOW DIFFICULT IS THE PROCESS?

The process of becoming a private pilot can be easily compared to obtaining your driver's license for a car.
